Introduction

This trip had long been planned as 10 days springtime visit to northern Greece - stretched out between compulsory goals of Prespa in far northwest and Dadia in far northeast and a brief visit to Mt. Olympos. Besides the archaeological sites at Vergina and Pella were high on the agenda and we were prepared to improvise other areas as these would fit in. In the end the site-list also included good areas as the Aliakmonas Delta (part of the greater Axios Delta), Apollonia lowland forest patch, the Porto Lagos-area, the Avas Gorge N of Alexandropolis and the easily accessible areas of the Evros Delta.

We arrived along with the first of summer temperatures and the good weather continued throughout our stay. Spring had been cold and snow was still present above 1200 m. Leafing was just about taking place in the beech-forest on the higher slopes in Prespa where everything became greener and greener during our stay. The Prepsa-area is unique and our stay there was fantastic. Beautiful landscapes, rich fauna and flora and nice people. The scenery around the pelican-colonies is nothing but world-class. - First half of May is too early for Mt. Olympos – yet it is a spectacular, breathtaking site and the orchid- and butterfly-rich lower slopes was a highlight for us. - The Apollonia-forest is a very special experience with its tree-breeding White Storks and colonies of Grey Heron. – While the Aliakmonas Delta was packed with birds, then the Porto Lagos area was perhaps a little empty in respect of migrants (waders etc.) - but the colony of Mediterranean Gull was very nice and besides a late record of Short-eared Owl and an early record of Rose-coloured Starling were unexpected. Avas Gorge had lost its large raptors compared to Jens's visit 23 years earlier where both Black Vulture and Imperial Eagle had been present. In general northern Greece is not as it reputedly used to be for bird of prey. However, what we had missed so far came up on the sky in Dadia N.P. – a rich diversity of vultures, eagles and buzzards. The vulture restaurant is a spectacular attraction – well situated and well run. Although we also learned about the managed implications where the (too) regular feeding seems to force the Black Vultures into a situation of strong intraspecific competition of food causing breeding-success to decrease. A more random accessibility of food will force the birds to disperse and then to be more successful whenever a carcass is located. But how then combine this with the visitor interest? – After Dadia we rushed to Evros and visited the extreme outer part to the sea, where foreigners are allowed in without permits.

Signposts damaged by gunshots and a new, but completely demolished toilet-building demonstrated the on-going conflict between conservation and locals. The Drana-lagoon is still illegally separated from the sea (since 1987), but at the EU-funded Information Centre up-coming plans for a major restoration project was explained. After Drana we went to some abandoned fish farms (so they looked) nearby and they were literally packed with birds. One pair of Spur-winged Plover and 10 Glossy Ibis' became the full stop to our birding in northern Greece (this time). Our return-flight to Denmark gave us one night in Athens and this in turn gave us one morning in the centre. We walked the Acropolis and ended in the Agora-area. Final full stop for all field activities was a large, very dark Marginated Tortoise tumbling around the ruins below the Theseion temple - in the third tortoise to the trip.

Mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, butterflies and orchids were noted throughout the trip and listed below. Multiple other plants, insects and other creatures were admired but no notes taken.

The ruins in Pella and the museum next to are worth a visit. The Vergina-museum build over the grave of King Phillip II is a must. The ruins in Dion below the distant Olympos peaks are nice - none the least for the peaceful rural setting – but unfortunately recent flooding of this low lying area had covered many of the mosaics with mud during our visit.

Itinerary

- 29/4 Departure 11.00 from Copenhagen to Athens with arrival 15.00 (local time, + 1 hour). Domestic flight from Athens 17.55 with arrival in Thessaloniki 19.00. Delivery of AVIS car and drive to Nea Chakidona where check-in on Hotel Phillipa 20.45. Supper at local taverna. Only birding from car.
- 30/4 Birding in the morning around Hotel Phillipa and prolonged stop at the nearby Pella archaeological site. Drive towards Prespa with shopping stop in Edessa. Lunch break at first reed beds shortly after Edessa and stop by viewpoint by Lake Agra reached by a sideway. Further driving towards Prespa with occasional brief stops, among which at the first Prespa viewpoint. Settled in at small hostel by the school in Ayios Yermanós.
- 1/5 All day in Prespa. Morning in Ayios Yermanós including visit to the SPP Visitors Centre. Most of the day spend around the Isthmus, but also a visit to the Juniper-forest and Psarades. Overnight in new taverna on Ayios Achillios, which today is reached by foot through the extravagant EU-funded pontoon bridge. May 1st is a public holiday in Greece and thousands of people visited the Tavernas in the area.
- 2/5 Morning at Ayios Yermanós around the office of SPP and followed by guided trip (Foteini Vakitsidou) to eastern shore of Micri Prespa with various stops: at the Kalé view-point, the abandoned EU-funded fish farm, the SPP water buffalo project, the Narcissus-meadow and the meadows north of Microlimni. Afterwards drive to Kastoria (to cash money) and on the return stop at roadside pool near Gávros. Late afternoon visit to forest slopes west of Pyli and the hill opposite Ayios Achillios with the good view over the pelican-colony. Supper in Ayios Yermanós with Yannis's family and friends.
- 3/5 Last morning walk on Ayios Achillios to the Basilica. Stop in Ayios Yermanos to say goodbye to Yannis & family. All day spend driving to Vergina. At first planned brief stops en route to Florina to check botanical sites. Then rather efficient drive through the farmland heading towards the town Ptolemaida, where we had a total down trip in not being able to find our way through a medium sized Greek provincial dump. After more than an hour desperate driving we succeed and reached through narrow byways and tiny villages the start

of a - according to our map - proper sized road cutting across the interesting mountain of Vermio. Locals then made it clear that the road were only passable with 4WD. Crisis! The planned detour to avoid only driving on highways was absolutely in vain. Well, we turned south and passed through enormous mining fields – so vast they started to become fascinating in their own extremeness. A couple of Long-legged Buzzards were different from the mess. Finally we reached a new highway and soon the show-clad top of Mt. Olympus towered up – we stopped to enjoy the view. Left the highway again and got immediately lost due to bad signposting by some road making. Managed to get back on track and reached Vergina at 20:00. Found good rooms at Pension Vergina close to the famous archaeological site.

- 4/5 Morning at the archaeological site with the impressive museum built over the grave of king Phillip II. To put it simple: Fantastic. Drive towards Dion with brief stop en route where the Aliakmonas Delta can be overlooked from the road. Prolonged stay at Dion where recent flooding unfortunately had covered the best mosaics with mud. Found hotel in Litochoro. Late afternoon drive up Mt. Olympos to Prionia to check the accessibility.
- 5/5 All day on Mt. Olympos. Few stops at lower, open slopes with plenty of orchids and butterflies during drive up to the end resort, Prionia, at 1100m. From here onwards by foot up through the forest to about 1800 m – the track mostly open and easily passable – but once blocked by a minor avalanche and fallen logs. However, this short stretch was passable with care. We never reached the alpine zones and obviously also came too early for those altitudes.
- 6/5 Took secondary roads to the Aliakmonas Delta and found near the village of N.Agathoupoli an EU-funded Visitors Centre overlooking the delta. Lots of birds and mating Nose-horned Viper (the most poisonous of European snakes). Back on the highway we headed east. Made a profitable lunch-stop at the patch of lowland forest north of Apollonia by Lake Volvi. Turn left from the main road by the EU-funded Visitors Center in Apollonia. Headed further east and reached Porto Lagos by late afternoon. Night at hotel in the coastal tourist resort Fanari.
- 7/5 Morning start around the hotel and along the coast with look at the three lagoons east of Fanari. Back to Porto Lagos and to the salines, where we had lunch. Drove on via Alexandropolis to Avas Gorge where stop in two hours. Late afternoon drive to Dadia N.P., where we found accommodation at the Ecocenter. Meet with Yorgos Catsadorakis in the evening.
- 8/5 All day in Dadia N.P. Walk to the vulture restaurant and stay in the hide 11-13.20. Late afternoon visits to Pouliánes and stream on the way towards Kotronia.
- 9/5 Earlier morning walk to the hide by the vulture restaurant were stay 06.55-07.50. Brief visits to meadows W of Dadia and Poulianes. Drive to Drana-lagoon in Evros and abandoned fishponds further west towards Alexandropolis. Drive to airport. Delayed flight to Athens 19.10-20.05.
- 10/5 Morning walk in Athens: Acropolis, Agora and the periphery of the Plaka. 09.15-13.00. Metro/bus to the airport. Flight to Copenhagen.

1. **Uidentified bats.** Various sizes of bats seen here and there around dusk. 3/5 1 small species Vergina.
2. **Eastern Hedgehog** (Østlig Pindsvin) *Erinaceus concolor*. 30/4 1 roadkill, 3/5 3 road kills, 4/5 8 road kills, 6/5 1 came to our table at the restaurant in Fanari and liked the bread, 7/5 2 road kill.
3. **Blind/Balkan Mole** (Blind/Balkan Muldvarp) *Talpa caeca/stankovici*. 30/4 1 taken by a White Stork Nea Chakidona. Being west of the Axios river a Mole must be one of these two species.
4. **European Souslik** (Sisel) *Spermophilus citellus*. 30/4 5-7 Pella, 4/5 1 Dion.
5. **Water Vole** (Vandrotte) *Arvicola terrestris*. 9/5 1 Drana Lagoon (Evros).
6. **Guenther's Vole** (Guenthers Markmus) *Microtus guentheri*. 8/5 2+ Poulianes (Dadia N.P.).
7. **Sibling Vole** (Russisk Markmus) *Microtus rossiaemeridionalis*. 7/5 1 Porto Lagos area.

Wild Cat (Vild kat) *Felis silvestris*. 8/5 tracks of a cat along the stream on the way towards Kotronia in Dadia N.P. could have been this species.
